IMPORTANT INFORMATION RE VACCINATIONS

We need to check the passports of all horses to ensure their vaccinations are up to date prior to a horse being unloaded from its trailer/box at the competition. We are unable to check on the day, so it is important that all copies of passports are emailed through to us. If you have already presented your passport to KTS in the last 9 months and notified us of your annual booster, then there is no need to present your passport. If you have not presented a passport to us then please email a copy of your horse's passport and vaccinations, your name and your horse's name one week before the event to ktstrec@gmail.com. You will receive an email if there are any issues with vaccinations.

- Please ensure that your vehicle is locked when you are not with it.
- Please clear up all droppings and spilt hay and take it home with you.
- Please compete and leave as soon as possible after your class. Results will be available soon after the class ends.

Warm Up

The small indoor arena can be used for warm up, it can get busy at times and there will be competitors with young and inexperienced horses. To keep us all safe please.

Please pass left to left

Respect tail ribbons

- Red if a horse is nervous or bad tempered when other horses come too close to their hindquarters.
- Green if the horse is young and/or a novice.

Announce if you want to jump and only jump as flagged (red on the right)

Additionally, you can ride on the bridgeway heading north west of the venue through Palmers Wood (heading away from the venue)

Competing

We have a really packed competition and ask you to help us keep to time please.

- Be ready for your round by standing at the large arena entrance
- Leave the arena promptly when you have finished your round
- Course walks must be completed quickly as we only have allocated 10 minutes please clear the arena when asked
- For the in hand, novice and newcomers you can have another horse standing in the large arena with you if this helps settle your horse

Shuttleworth Arena Trec – getting to the venue

Shuttleworth Equine Centre, Old Warden, Beds.



Take the exit from the A1 at the roundabout by Sainsburys into Hill Lane, cross the next roundabout continuing on Hill Lane. The lane to the Equine Centre is on the right hand side and will have a KTS sign. Continue along the track (which is single lane in places)

We have a very limited amount to parking and a lot of competitors so you will be asked to park by our attendant. Please do not arrive before 8.30 am
